<p>Science</p>	<p>The District has adopted the Next Generation Science Standards. <p>Social Studies (includes geography and history)</p>	<p>The District has adopted the Wisconsin Model Academic Standards for Social Studies. The five strands of the social studies standards encompass history, geography, behavioral science, economics, and political science. The model standards include both content standards and performance standards. <p>Career and Technical Education (includes Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources; Business and Information Technology; Family and Consumer Science; Health Science; Marketing, Management and Entrepreneurship; and Technology and Engineering)</p>	<p>The District has adopted the Wisconsin Common Career and Technical Standards (WCCTS) for each of the CTE areas. <p>Art, Music and Physical Education</p>	<p>The District has adapted curriculum to the National Standards in Art and Music. The Art and Music standards embed the processes of Creating, Performing, Responding and Connecting into the content and performance standards. Although there are several strands and sub-strands as part of the larger body of standards, the District standards include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Art: Visual Arts ● Music: Music Composition and Theory, Harmonizing Instruments, Traditional and Emerging Ensembles <p>A complete copy of these standards can be located and reviewed at this Internet address: http://www.nationalartsstandards.org/</p> <p>The District has adopted SHAPE America’s National Standards for Physical Education (2013). The term “physical literacy” underpins the standards. The five main standards center around:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Motor skills and movement patterns ● Application of concepts, strategies and tactics related to movement and performance ● Knowledge and skills to achieve a health-enhancing level of physical activity and fitness ● Personal and social behaviors ● Valuing a fit life for health, enjoyment, challenge, and social interaction <p>The standards include grade-level outcomes of what a student should know and be able to do.
