

**MINUTES OF BOARD OF EDUCATION  
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF ARCADIA  
SPECIAL MEETING  
NOVEMBER 1, 2017**

A special meeting of the Board of Education of the School District of Arcadia was held in the high school room 219 in the City of Arcadia, County of Trempealeau, Wisconsin, on Wednesday, November 1, 2017.
