Swimming Lessons

The School District of Arcadia offers the American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety Courses. Our fully qualified instructors will take you through all the stages of swimming development in planned lessons. We want every child's swimming instruction experience to be positive and fun filled.

Registration. If your child is enrolled in summer school select swimming lessons as a class. For swimming lessons that take place July 23-August 3 or August 6 -17 use the registration form included in this packet.

There will also be a parent sign up for swimming lessons on May 30 from 4-5 in the MS Commons. Or return the included form by May 11.

Gymnastics

Summer school gymnastics is open to all students entering kindergarten through 5th grade. Students do not need to sign up for all of summer school in order to participate in gymnastics. However, the number of students in each class is limited, so sign up now.

Registration. Fill out the "Elementary Registration" form for summer school, which includes a permission slip and waiver for gymnastics.

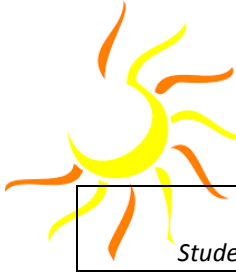
When will the classes be? The classes will coincide with the elementary summer school sessions.

- 1:15-2:00 Students entering grades K-1
- 2:00-3:00 Students entering grades 2-3
- 3:00-4:00 Students entering grades 4-5
- 4:00-5:00 Students entering grades 6-9

Where will the classes take place? Classes will take place at the high school gymnastics area on the 2nd floor. Please enter through the HS Commons and come up to the 2nd floor to pick up your child.

Transportation. There will be a bus from the elementary school to the high school for students that are enrolled in summer school and the kindergarten/1st grade (1:15) gymnastics class. Students in this class will need their own transportation home. Students in all other classes will need to provide their own transportation to and from class.

Do I need to buy any special clothes for gymnastics? No. While leotards are ideal, they are by no means required. Gymnasts should simply wear comfortable shorts and a t-shirt or tank top that can be tucked in. Please bring a hair band for long hair

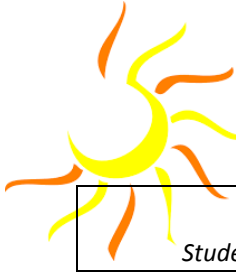

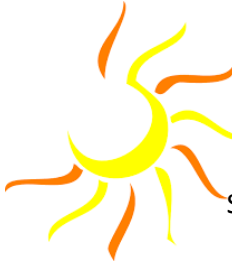
